# Places to Explore

There are many incredible and interesting places to explore in the area. Take a walk through the dunes, along the sandy shores, or see what beauty lies in the forest. We have made a list of our favorite outdoor spots in the area. Hope you check them out and enjoy them like we do.

### National Seashore Bike Trail

Along the National Seashore there is a biking trail that winds through the Provinceland Dunes and Beech Forest. This is an incredible 8 mile paved bike loop you do not want to miss. Bike rentals available at Gale Force Bikes in P-town.

### <u>Snail Trail</u>

Take a walk through the dunes of the outer cape. This trail was featured on National Geographic and leads from Snail Road all the way out to the beaches along the Atlantic Ocean. Be sure to bring water as it is fully exposed.

### Race Point Beach

### White Cedar Swamp Trail

For the most adventurous folks visiting the Cape, the White Cedar Swamp Boardwalk is a great place to go for a hike. The trail itself is only a few miles in length, but takes you through the largest White Cedar Swamp on the outer Cape. A good place to spend the day. Don't forget to bring bug spray!

### Leaving the House

#### Please read before departure!

**11:00 AM DEPARTURE.** Cleaners need full-allotted time to prepare for incoming guests. Late Check-Outs can be prearranged at **\$150.00/Hour** 

If departing early: Please call (508)454-3795 so we can inform the cleaning staff.

#### House Conditions Upon Departure

1. All beach towels **must** be washed and put away.

Do not make beds on departure day unless you have washed the sheets. We always appreciate when guests decide to clean the sheets and remake the beds at the end of their stay. If you choose to do so please write a note labeled "CLEAN" and place it on any bed that is clean or hasn't been used during your stay.
Washing of any additional laundry (i.e. bath towels) is greatly appreciated. If choosing to wash any laundry please place them in laundry room on top counter as write a note saying "CLEAN." Thank you.

4. Place all dirty laundry on the floor and **NOT** the counter.

5. Dishwasher should be emptied or running when cleaners arrive. **NO** dirty dishes in sink or on counters.

6. In general our cleaners are cleaning after your stay. **NOT** your party!
